

Lac Ste Anne Historical Society



The Lac Ste Anne Pioneer Museum was started in August 1959 by members of the Historical Society to house artifacts of the early settlers of the area. Originally located on Hwy 43 near Sangudo it was moved to it's present site at Rochfort Bridge in 1992. A 24x40 ft extension was started in 1996 and completed in 1997. Three other buildings add to the site.

Built by the Society in 1993
